1 Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “PFAS-Free Procure-
5 ment Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PROCUREMENT OF CERTAIN**

7 **ITEMS CONTAINING PERFLUOROOCANE**

8 **SULFONATE (PFOS) OR**

9 **PERFLUOROOCANOIC ACID (PFOA).**

10 Beginning on October 1, 2025, the head of an execu-
11 tive agency may not enter into a new contract for the pro-

1 curement of a covered item that contains perfluorooctane
2 sulfonate (PFOS) or perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA).

3 **SEC. 3. PRIORITY PROCUREMENT OF PRODUCTS NOT CON-**
4 **TAINING PFAS.**

5 The head of an executive agency shall prioritize the
6 procurement of covered items, where available and prac-
7 ticable, that do not contain harmful perfluoroalkyl or
8 polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

9 **SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.**

10 In this Act:

11 (1) EXECUTIVE AGENCY DEFINED.—The term
12 “executive agency” has the meaning given the term
13 in section 133 of title 41, United States Code.

14 (2) COVERED ITEMS.—The term “covered
15 items” means—

16 (A) nonstick cookware and cooking uten-
17 sils; and

18 (B) furniture, carpets, and rugs treated
19 with stain-resistant coatings.
