5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 7 days after the

6 date of enactment of this Act, the Director of the United

7 States Secret Service shall submit to the appropriate con-

8 gressional committees a report that contains any and all

9 information in the possession of the United States Secret

10 Service relating to the failed assassination attempt on the

1 life of Donald J. Trump in Butler, Pennsylvania, on July  
2 13, 2024, including—

3 (1) the identity, motive, method, and actions of  
4 the shooter;

5 (2) requests for additional resources or protec-  
6 tive measures for Donald J. Trump, his campaign,  
7 his organization, or any entity involved in preparing  
8 for the event;

9 (3) preparations for the event in Butler, Penn-  
10 sylvania, by the United States Secret Service and  
11 other law enforcement entities;

12 (4) response by United States Secret Service to  
13 the shooter; and

14 (5) information on the ensuing investigation by  
15 the Federal Bureau of Investigation and any other  
16 investigating agency.

17 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “appro-  
18 priate congressional committees” means—

19 (1) the Committee on Homeland Security and  
20 Governmental Affairs and the Committee on the Ju-  
21 diciary of the Senate; and

22 (2) the Committee on Oversight and Account-  
23 ability and the Committee on the Judiciary of the  
24 House of Representatives.
