AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE intended
to be proposed by Ms. HASSAN

Viz:

1 Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Northern Border Secu-
5 rity Enhancement and Review Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NORTHERN BORDER THREAT ANALYSIS AND**
7 **STRATEGY.**

8 (a) NORTHERN BORDER THREAT ANALYSIS.—Sec-
9 tion 3(a) of the Northern Border Security Review Act
10 (Public Law 114–267) is amended—

1 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
2 striking “180 days after the date of enactment of
3 this Act” and inserting “September 2, 2025, and
4 every 3 years thereafter”;

5 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (2) and (3) as
6 paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively; and

7 (3) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-
8 lowing:

9 “(2) an assessment of recent changes in the
10 amount and demographics of apprehensions at the
11 northern border, including an analysis of apprehen-
12 sion changes at the sector level.”.

13 (b) NORTHERN BORDER STRATEGY UPDATES.—Sec-
14 tion 3 of the Northern Border Security Review Act (Public
15 Law 114–267) is amended—

16 (1) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
17 section (d); and

18 (2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
19 lowing:

20 “(c) NORTHERN BORDER STRATEGY UPDATES.—
21 The Secretary of Homeland Security shall update the De-
22 partment of Homeland Security’s northern border strat-
23 egy not later than September 2, 2026, and not later than
24 every 5 years thereafter, and shall incorporate the results
25 of the most recent threat analysis in each such update.”.

1 (c) CLASSIFIED BRIEFINGS.—Section 3 of the North-
2 ern Border Security Review Act, as amended by sub-
3 section (b), is further amended by adding at the end the
4 following:

5 “(e) CLASSIFIED BRIEFINGS.—Not later than 30
6 days after the submission of each threat analysis pursuant
7 to subsection (a), the Secretary of Homeland Security
8 shall provide a classified briefing regarding such analysis
9 to the appropriate congressional committees.”.

10 (d) IMPLEMENTATION OF CERTAIN GOVERNMENT
11 ACCOUNTABILITY OFFICE RECOMMENDATIONS.—Not
12 later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of
13 this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security, acting
14 through the Executive Assistant Commissioner of Air and
15 Marine Operations of U.S. Customs and Border Protec-
16 tion, shall develop performance measures to assess the ef-
17 fectiveness of Air and Marine Operations at securing the
18 northern border between ports of entry in the air and mar-
19 itime environments.

20 **SEC. 3. NO ADDITIONAL FUNDS.**

21 No additional funds are authorized to be appro-
22 priated for the purpose of carrying out this Act.
