AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE intended
to be proposed by Mr. PETERS

Viz:

1 Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Streamlining Law En-
5 forcement Information Sharing Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPTROLLER GENERAL REPORT ON THE HOME-**
7 **LAND SECURITY INFORMATION NETWORK.**

8 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
9 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
10 shall submit to the Committee on Homeland Security and
11 Governmental Affairs and the Select Committee on Intel-

1 ligence of the Senate and the Committee on Homeland Se-
2 curity and the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
3 ligence of the House of Representatives a report that in-
4 cludes the following:

5 (1) An examination of how the Homeland Secu-
6 rity Information Network is used to share informa-
7 tion with—

8 (A) Federal, State, local, Tribal, and terri-
9 torial law enforcement and governmental part-
10 ners; and

11 (B) private sector partners and nonprofit
12 partners from across a variety of sectors, com-
13 munities, and geographic locations.

14 (2) A comparison of the use, by such law en-
15 forcement partners, on both desktops and mobile ap-
16 plications of the Homeland Security Information
17 Network to the use of other tools, including
18 JusticeConnect of the Federal Bureau of Investiga-
19 tion, which facilitate real-time exchanges of intel-
20 ligence among such law enforcement partners.

21 (3) An assessment of the cost, effectiveness,
22 and efficacy of the Homeland Security Information
23 Network.

24 (4) An assessment of the current policies of the
25 Homeland Security Information Network and the ef-

1 efficacy of such policies in protecting the civil rights,
2 civil liberties, and privacy of individuals.

3 (5) An analysis of any other information the
4 Comptroller General determines appropriate.
