3 **SECTION 1. JOHN CHARLES TRAUB POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 1765 Camp Hill Bypass in Camp
6 Hill, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the
7 “John Charles Traub Post Office”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “John Charles Traub
3 Post Office”.
