Dear Mr. McFarland:

We are writing to request that your office review the security clearance background investigation(s) conducted for Aaron Alexis, the alleged perpetrator of the mass killing of at least twelve people at the Navy Yard complex in Washington, D.C., on September 16, 2013. Mr. Alexis reportedly was a Navy subcontractor employee with a history of misconduct, including previous arrests relating to the use of firearms.¹ Specifically, we request that your office determine:

- (1) Mr. Alexis' clearance level and status at the time of the shooting;
- (2) Whether OPM's Federal Investigative Services or one of its contractors performed Mr. Alexis' background investigations;
- (3) Which agencies granted Mr. Alexis' initial security clearance and subsequent clearance renewals and the dates of those approvals;
- (4) Whether the proper review procedures were followed for all of Mr. Alexis' background investigation reports;
- (5) Whether and how Mr. Alexis' background investigations addressed his pattern of misconduct, including his reported arrests on charges relating to firearms in 2004 and 2010 and his arrest for disorderly conduct in 2009.

We request that you keep us informed of your investigation's findings. 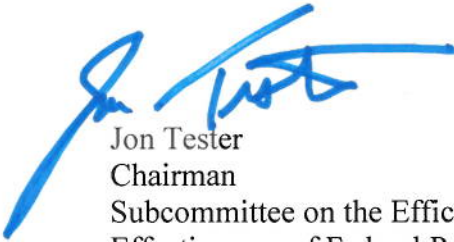
