Dear Ms. Hensen:

We are writing to invite you to testify before the Subcommittee on Financial and Contracting Oversight at a hearing entitled, "Fraud and Abuse in Army Recruiting Contracts." The hearing will be held on Tuesday, February 4, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. in Room SD-342 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building.

The purpose of the hearing is to examine reports of pervasive fraud, abuse, and mismanagement in the award and administration of contracts for the Army National Guard's Recruiting Assistance Program (G-RAP). In particular, the hearing will examine reports indicating a widespread breakdown in oversight and accountability and the failure to follow multiple laws, regulations, and policies. The hearing will also examine reports that millions of dollars were distributed fraudulently to Army National Guard members.

Your testimony should address the above topics. You should also address your involvement in the G-RAP contracting process both as the G-RAP contracting officer for the Army National Guard and in your later role as Contracts Manager at Docupak. The Subcommittee requests that witnesses summarize your testimony in 5 minutes, although a longer written statement may be submitted for the official record. This will allow adequate time for witnesses to engage in questions and answers with members of the Subcommittee. Subcommittee rules require that all testimony be submitted by no later than 10:00 A.M. on Friday, January 31, 2014. Please send official correspondence relating to this invitation, including an electronic copy of the witnesses' written statement and a brief one page biography for each witness, to Subcommittee Clerk Kelsey Stroud at Kelsey_Stroud@hsgac.senate.gov.

The jurisdiction of the Subcommittee on Financial and Contracting Oversight is set forth in Senate Rule XXV clause 1(k); Senate Resolution 445 section 101 (108th Congress); and Senate Resolution 64 (113th Congress).
