Dear Madam Chairman:

I am writing in response to your May 15, 2014, letter to Inspector General Daniel R. Levinson concerning whistleblower allegations that Cognosante, a Healthcare.gov subcontractor, is engaged in fraudulent business practices wherein it pays its contract employees to do no work for days, and sometimes weeks, at a time. You have requested that the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Office of Inspector General, evaluate these whistleblower allegations and, if warranted, undertake a thorough investigation.

We have forwarded the information provided by your office to our Kansas City Regional Office for review. This office is responsible for criminal and civil investigations of fraud and misconduct related to HHS programs and operations in Missouri, the State where the alleged fraud is taking place. On the basis of the results of the review, we will determine the appropriate course of action.
