

1 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall
2 post, maintain, and update in accordance with
3 paragraph (2), on a publicly available website of
4 the Department, a daily report of all covered
5 contract awards.

6 (B) CONTENTS.—Each report under this
7 paragraph shall include, for each covered con-
8 tract award, information relating to—

9 (i) the contract number, modification
10 number, or delivery order number;

11 (ii) the contract type;

12 (iii) the amount obligated for the
13 award;

14 (iv) the total contract value for the
15 award, including all options;

16 (v) the description of the purpose for
17 the award;

18 (vi) the number of proposals or bids
19 received;

20 (vii) the name and address of the ven-
21 dor, and whether the vendor is a small
22 business;

23 (viii) the period and primary place of
24 performance for the award;

1 (ix) whether the award is multiyear;

2 and

3 (x) the contracting office.

4 (2) UPDATE.—The Secretary shall make up-
5 dates referred to in paragraph (1) not later than 5
6 business days after the date on which a covered con-
7 tract is authorized or modified.

8 (3) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Paragraph (1) shall
9 take effect on the date that is 180 days after the
10 date of enactment of this Act.

11 (b) UNDEFINITIZED CONTRACT ACTION OR DEFINI-
12 TIZED AMOUNT.—If a covered contract award reported
13 under subsection (a) includes an undefinitized contract ac-
14 tion, the Secretary shall—

15 (1) report the estimated total contract value for
16 the award and the amount obligated upon award;
17 and

18 (2) once there is a definitized amount for the
19 award, update the total contract value and amount
20 obligated.

21 (c) EXEMPTION.—Each report required under sub-
22 section (a) shall not include covered contract awards for
23 which synopsis was exempted under section 5.202(a)(1)
24 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation, or any successor
25 thereto.

1 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

2 (1) COVERED CONTRACT AWARD.—The term
3 “covered contract award”—

4 (A) means a contract action of the Depart-
5 ment with a total contract value of not less
6 than \$4,000,000, including unexercised options;
7 and

8 (B) includes—

9 (i) contract awards governed by the
10 Federal Acquisition Regulation;

11 (ii) modifications to a contract award
12 that increase the total value, expand the
13 scope of work, or extend the period of per-
14 formance;

15 (iii) orders placed on a multiple-award
16 or multiple-agency contract that includes
17 delivery or quantity terms that are indefi-
18 nite;

19 (iv) other transaction authority agree-
20 ments; and

21 (v) contract awards made with other
22 than full and open competition.

23 (2) DEFINITIZED AMOUNT.—The term “defini-
24 tized amount” means the final amount of a covered

1 contract award after agreement between the Depart-
2 ment and the contractor at issue.

3 (3) DEPARTMENT.—The term “Department”
4 means the Department of Homeland Security.

5 (4) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
6 the Secretary of Homeland Security.

7 (5) SMALL BUSINESS.—The term “small busi-
8 ness” means an entity that qualifies as a small busi-
9 ness concern, as defined under section 3 of the
10 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632).

11 (6) TOTAL CONTRACT VALUE.—The term “total
12 contract value” means the total amount of funds ex-
13 pected to be provided to the contractor at issue
14 under the terms of the contract through the full pe-
15 riod of performance.

16 (7) UNDEFINITIZED CONTRACT ACTION.—The
17 term “undefinitized contract action” means any con-
18 tract action for which the contract terms, specifica-
19 tions, or price is not established prior to the start
20 of the performance of the covered contract award.

21 (e) SUNSET.—This section shall cease to have force
22 or effect on the date that is 5 years after the date of enact-
23 ment of this Act.
