AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE intended
to be proposed by Mr. JOHNSON

Viz:

1 Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “DHS Intelligence Ro-
5 tational Assignment Program Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-**
7 **GRAM.**

8 Section 844 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
9 (6 U.S.C. 414) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

1 “(b) INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-
2 GRAM.—

3 “(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 1 year
4 after the date of enactment of this subsection, the
5 Secretary shall establish an Intelligence Rotational
6 Assignment Program as part of the Rotation Pro-
7 gram under subsection (a).

8 “(2) ELIGIBILITY.—The Intelligence Rotational
9 Assignment Program shall be open to employees
10 serving in analyst positions in an intelligence compo-
11 nent of the Department, analyst positions in the
12 United States Secret Service, and other positions in
13 the Department, as determined appropriate by the
14 Secretary.

15 “(3) COORDINATION.—The Chief Human Cap-
16 ital Officer shall carry out the responsibilities relat-
17 ing to the Rotation Program that are specified in
18 subsection (a)(3)(B) with respect to the Intelligence
19 Rotational Assignment Program under this sub-
20 section, to the extent those responsibilities are appli-
21 cable to the Intelligence Rotational Assignment Pro-
22 gram.”.
